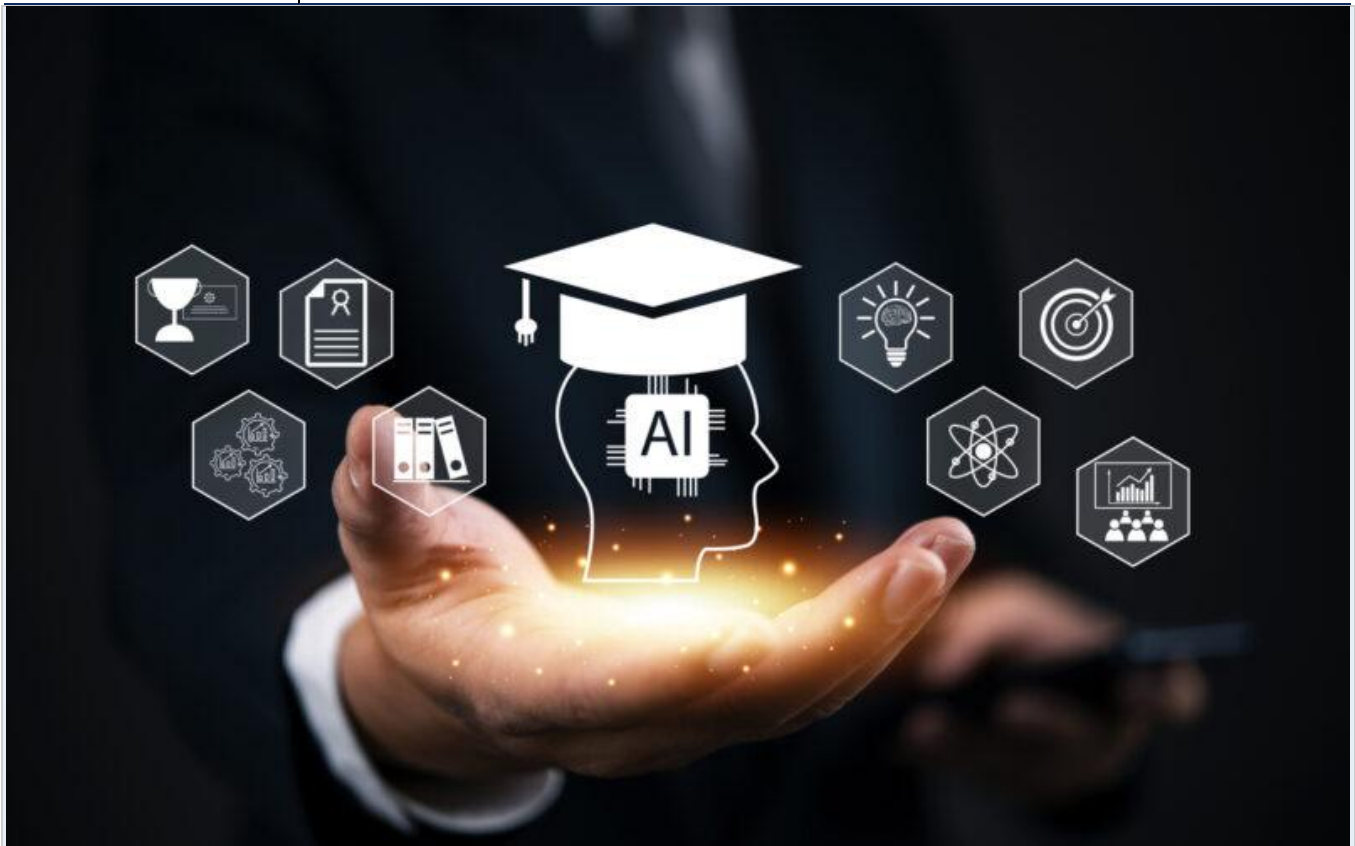


Figure 1: The AI enhanced professional. Credit: Shutterstock
