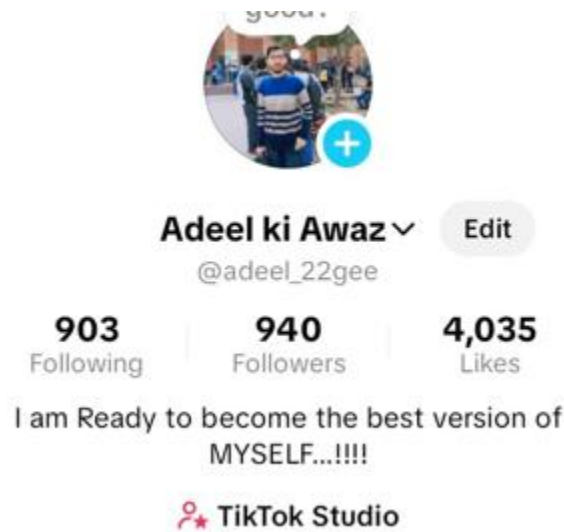


Figure 1: Young Pakistani is working on digital platforms. Credit: Author
